

Over-the-Counter Pain Relief for Adults

IMPORTANT: Tell us if you are not able to take acetaminophen or ibuprofen.

For the next 3 days, you may take ibuprofen and acetaminophen together every 4-6 hours -OR-

Alternate between ibuprofen and acetaminophen every 3 hours.

Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin)



> Do not take more than 3200mg within 24 hours

Acetaminophen (Tylenol)



- > Whenever possible, do not take more than 3000mg a day to help control pain.
- > Never take more than 4000mg within 24 hours
- > There is acetaminophen (APAP) in Tylenol #2, Tylenol #3, Vicodin and Percocet. DO NOT take additional Tylenol when you are taking those medications.
